Application

- Time for entrance: Spring semester (April) and Autumn semester (September)
- Dates for application : For 2023 spring entrance 2022.8.19-8.26 / 2023.1.28-2.4,
• For 2023 autumn entrance 2023.1.28-2.4/ 2023.5.11-5.18
- Examination: Students living in foreign countries will be selected by documents only with no fee. For students living in Japan, there is an examination on campus.
- Tuition fee: about 500,000 Japanese Yen/year (this includes a 40% reduction for foreign students)
- Scholarship: some scholarship from university recommendation and other foundations are available to apply after the entrance.
